


MASKIDU MAVELI

On 5/1/22 Department of Mathematics celebrated new year and X-mas , conducted cultural events likeX-MAS song competition .10 students participated











'etc.' Annual Media Fest


READING DAY CELEBRATION








READING DAY CELEBRATION
