Evidence of success :

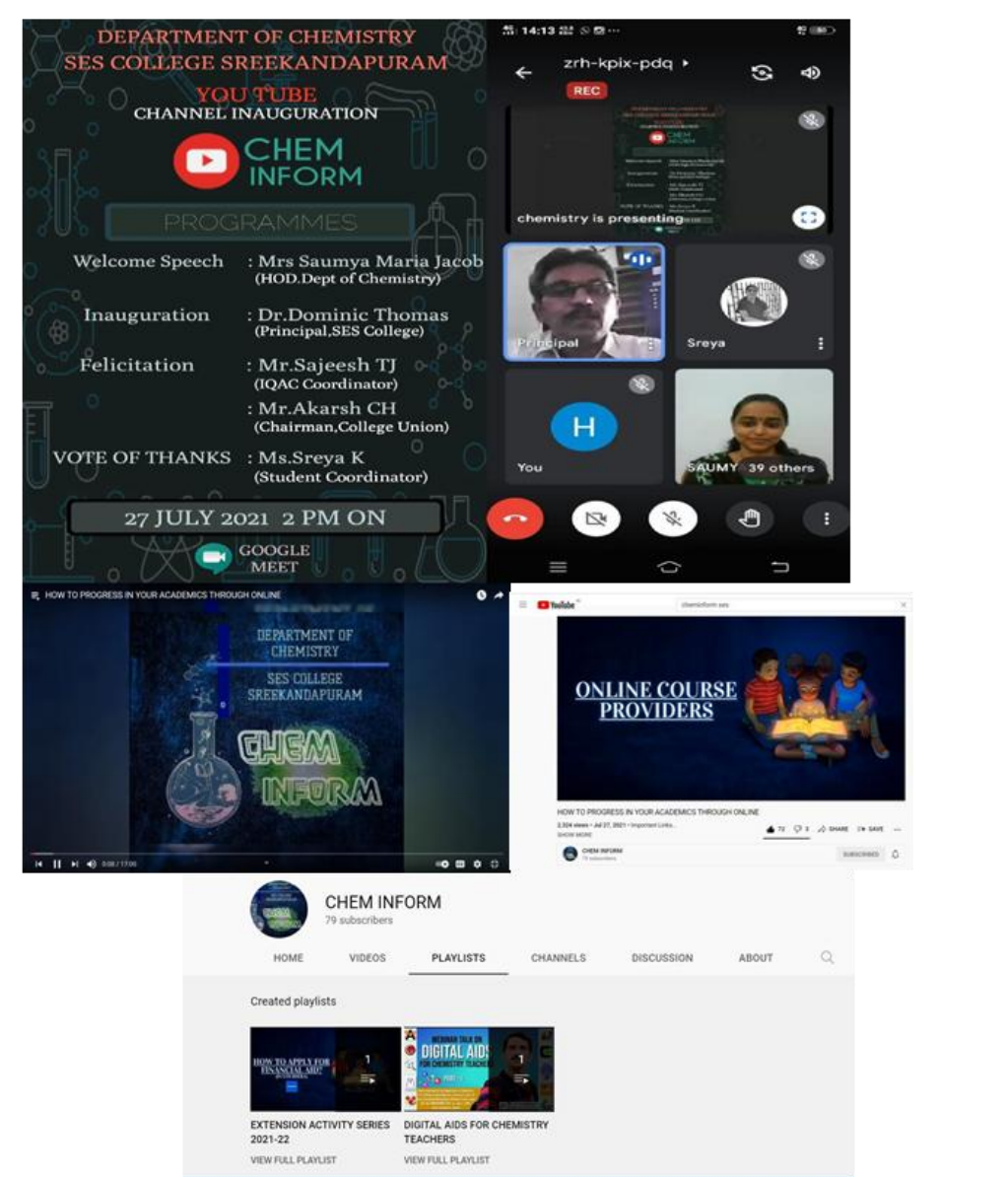

Human resource and finance were the major resources Required. Availability of students due to the unseemly conduct of examination during Covid 19 times and financial constraints were the problems encountered.


YOUTUBE CHANNEL INAUGURATION (SHARING KNOWLEDGE)

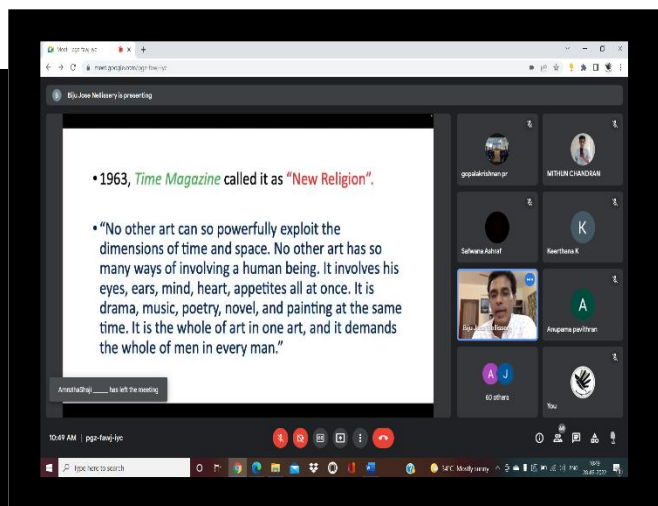
E.A.S.E.S. TALKS

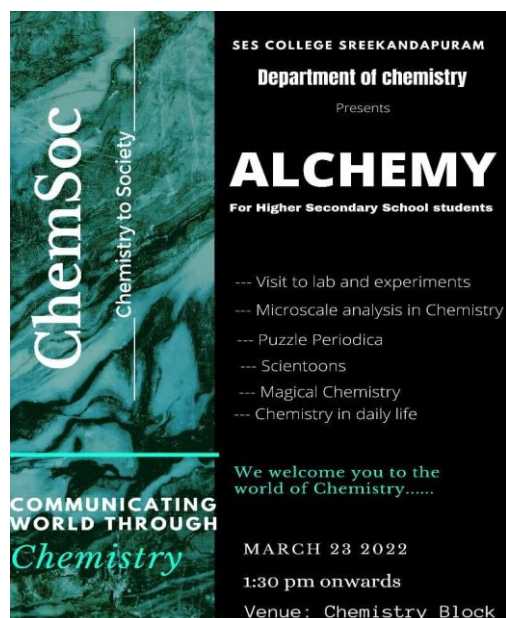
COTOPIA-A SOCIAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME

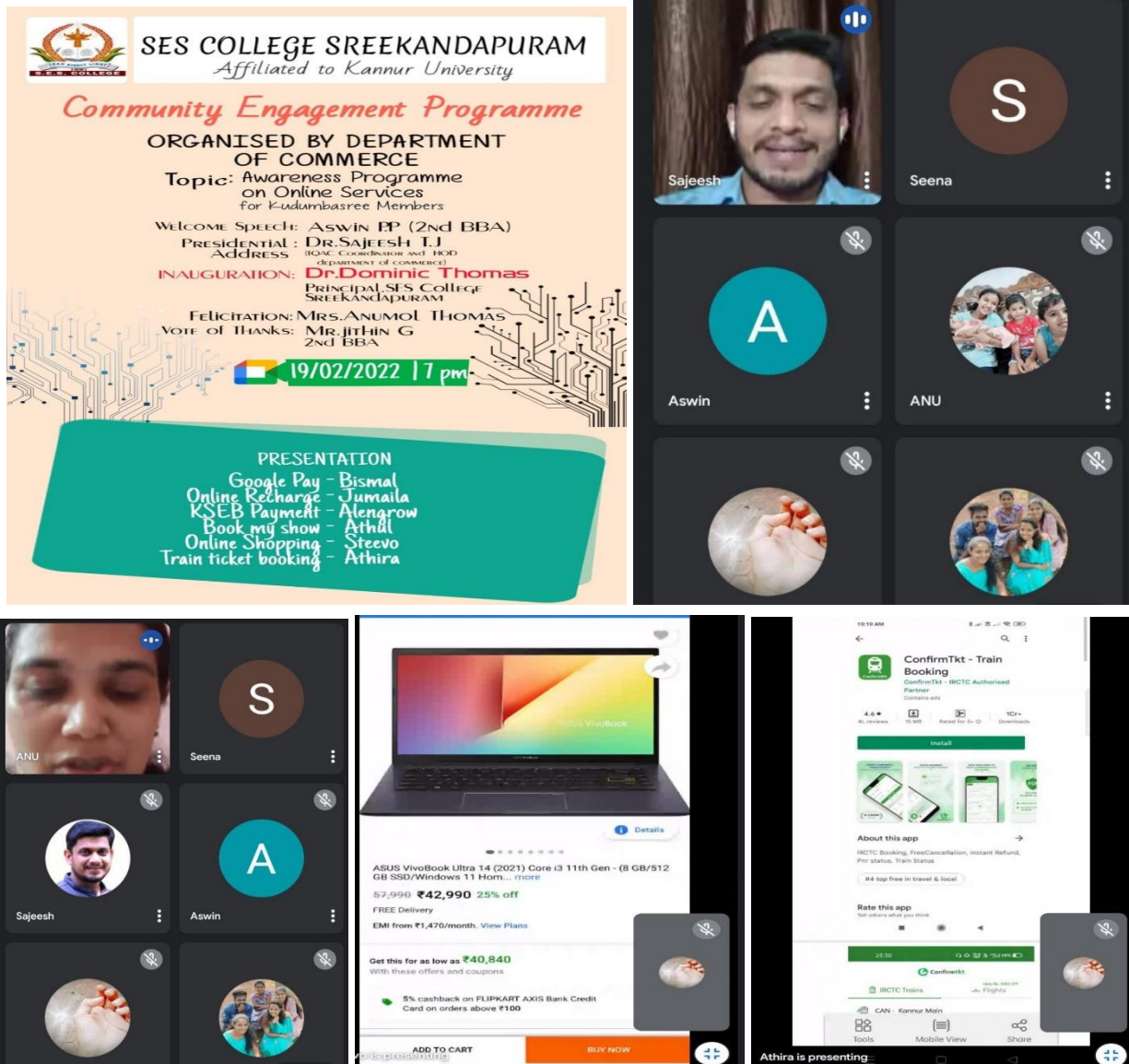


SOCIAL EXTENSION- VISIT ST. GEORGIA SPECIAL SCHOOL
