
Problems Encountered and Resources Required:


Webinar on TV Journalism

E.A.S.E.S. TALKS




Career Guidance Class and inauguration of Orientation Programme & Bridge Course



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
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FINANCIAL LITERACY & AWARENESS TO STUDENTS




CARREAR GUIDANCE WEBINAR








Career guidance Seminar exclusively for the Final year B.A. English


Orientation class from CIPET Palakkad (Career guidance)


EXTENSION ACTIVITY- HAND SANITIZER PREPARATION




SOCIAL EXTENSION- VISIT ST. GEORGIA SPECIAL SCHOOL



SOLVE THE MATHS HORIZON ENGLISH SCHOOL




