




Department of Commerce-BBA Activity Report 2022-2023






Seminar on Research Methodology


Basic of arithmetic, logical reasoning, average, ratio, proportion, interest, time value of money, depreciation.

ROLE PLAY










Career Guidance Programme




Language and communication skills program

Job Expo










Women Empowerment Programme

INDUSTRIAL VISIT AND LINKAGE AGREEMENT



EXTENSION ACTIVITY-CHEMPERI KARUNALAYAM


