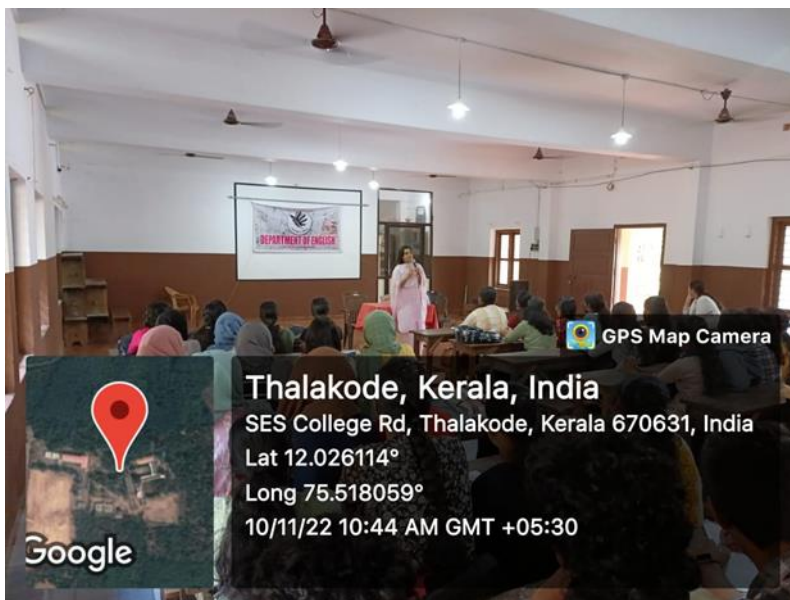


ACTIVITY REPORT 2022-2023

TOPIC: WHY LITERATURE?

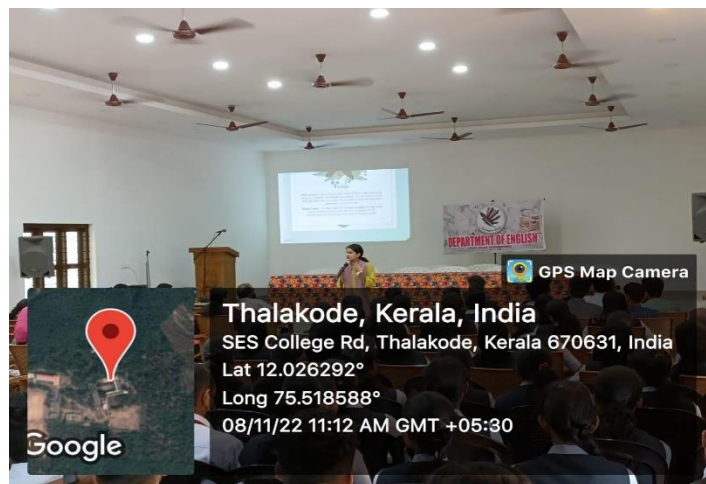

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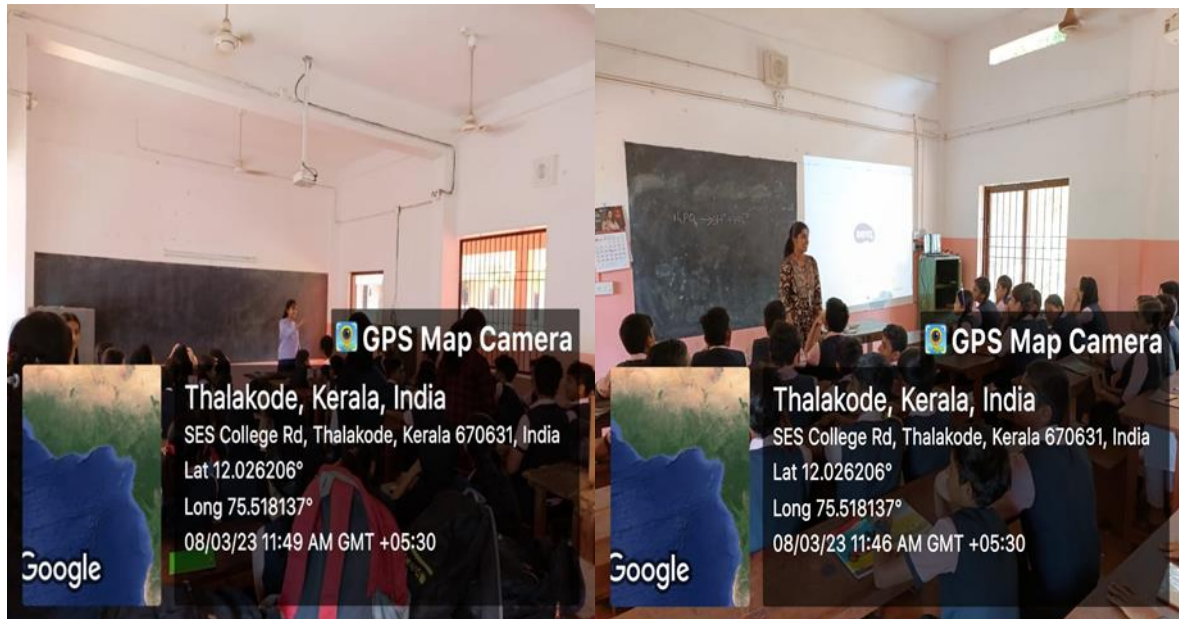
WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME
