TEACHERS FEEDBACK

For the successful and effective implementation of the curriculum it is essential to have an understanding of the impact of the curriculum among the various stakeholders especially teachers. To gather the views of the teachers regarding the curricular implementation, annual feedback is collected from all the teachers. The feedback are collected and analysed and the overall output is used for improving the effectiveness of curricular implementation at the institutional level. An awareness of the teachers feedback enables us to figure out the aspects in curricular implementation which requires modifications. It also helps the teachers to ensure the design of curriculum in an effective manner during their participation at the curricular restructuring process.

Teachers opinion on the following statements are measured in a five-point scale (Excellent 1, Very Good -2, Good-3, Average4, Poor- 5).

Response Interpretation

- 1. Interpretation: 51.75 % of the teachers rated the curricular framework to be very good, 31% responded it to be excellent, and the rest 17.25% opted it to be good
- 2. Interpretation: 55.17% of the teachers rated very good, 24.13% teachers are satisfied with the sequence of courses and rated excellent, 20.7% are of the view that it is good still there is room for improvement
- 3. Interpretation: 55.17% of the teachers believe that the depth of the syllabus is compatible to the learning competencies of student, 24.13% believes that compatibility range is excellent 17.25% believes the syllabus is beneficial for them and remaining 3.45% rated it to be average
- 4. Interpretation: 51.75% of teachers rate distribution of credits to be very good, 27.5% consider it to be excellent well structured & fair, while 20.75% of teachers feels the credit distribution to be good.
- 5. Interpretation: 37.93% of teachers rated Very good on the relevance of reference materials 31.03% opined it to be excellent while 24.13% of teachers considers the relevance as good and 6.90% rated it as satisfactory

- 6. Interpretation: 55.17.% of teachers believes that curriculum rates very good in catering to the need of the society, 20.70% rated it as excellent. 24.15% believes the curriculum is good and really efficient in serving it purpose
- 7. Interpretation: 44.83% of the teachers are of the opinion that the syllabus content is very good, balanced in terms of load on them and students..20.70% believe that content is excellent well contained and 27.58% opined that to be good while 6.89 rated average.
- 8. Interpretation: 20.70% claims it to be excellent. 55.17% of the teachers believe that the curriculum contributes efficiently in broadening the perspective and career opportunity of students, 20.70% believes that the contribution of curriculum is good.
- 9. Interpretation: 51.72% of teachers rate the Potential of the students in understanding course objectives to be very good, rated it to be excellent, 17.24% teachers rate the Potential to be excellent and 17.24% consider it to be good. 13.29% rated it to be average.
- 10. Interpretation: 48.28% of the teachers are of the opinion that the Choice of Elective/optional papers is Very Good, 20.70% believes it to be excellent in its aspects & 31.03% believes it to be good.
- 11. Teacher's Suggestions & Observations to improve the overall quality of the curriculum

Inference: Teachers are satisfied to a great extent with the curriculum, keeping in mind the best interest of the students, some faculties have suggested certain modifications The College through successful implementation of curriculum made advancements in curricular implementation thus improving the academic atmosphere of the college. The college hopes that the vibrant and inclusive curriculum merged with the untiring efforts of the Teaching staff and the support of the student community will enable the college to scale greater heights of excellence.

The teachers are generally satisfied with current evaluation scheme. The institutional implementation of the curriculum was rated excellent, a few believes that there is still room for improvement


A few have suggested certain modifications

Curricular Evaluation by Students

- 1.Response of students regarding the curriculum in enhancing competencies of the students. Interpretation: 38.91% of the students believe that the curriculum is excellent in enhancing their competencies, 44.80% believe that the curriculum is very good , and rest 9.05% believe that the curriculum is good . 6.79% Average and 0.45% Poor
- 2. Student's opinion regarding the syllabus and teaching methods.

Interpretation: 35.75% of the students believe that the teaching methods adopted is excellent, 47.96% believe that the methods adopted are very good , 15.38% believe that the methods adopted are good and 0.90% believe it to be average

3. Student's opinion regarding usefulness of the choice of electives (open) in providing for employability skills& soft skills.

Interpretation: 31.67% of the students are of the opinion that the choice of electives & open courses is beneficial for them and remaining 42.99% are of the opinion that the choice of electives & open is very good and 17.65% rated it as good while 8% rated it as average, 0.90% rated it as poor.

4. Student's opinion regarding the Relevance and Appropriateness of the units prescribed in the curriculum

Interpretation: 37.56% of students are of the opinion that the units prescribed in the curriculum are relevant and appropriate, 38.46% are of the opinion that curriculum has very good relevance, 20.36% rated as having good influence on class.. and remaining 3.62% rated the aspect as average

5. Student's opinion regarding the allocation of credits to the courses

Interpretation: 80% of students are of the opinion that the allocation of credits to the courses is efficient and transparent and remaining 14% believe that allocation of credits is good and remaining 25.5% rated the aspect as average,0.5% rated poor

6. Student's opinion regarding the regular updation of Syllabus to meet the demand of the students

Interpretation: 73% of students are of the opinion that updation of Syllabus meet their demand very good and 23.5% think that the updation is good, and 2.7% think that the updation is average, and 1% think that the updation is poor

.7. Student's opinion regarding the size of the syllabus in terms of load on them

Interpretation: 68% of the students are of the opinion that the size of the syllabus in terms of load on them are well balanced & integrated and remaining 22.5% are of the opinion that the practical and theoretical size of syllabus are composed good and remaining 8% rated it average, and remaining 1% rated it poor.

8. Student's opinion regarding the Evaluation scheme designed for each course

Interpretation: 80% of the students are adequately satisfied with current evaluation scheme, 16% believes that the Evaluation scheme is good and proper, 4% believes the scheme is average

9. Student's rating of the Course Objective/ Program Objective

Interpretation: 80% of students rated the objectives as excellent/very good and the remaining 18.1% opined that the objectives are good, 1% rated it as average

10. Student's opinion regarding the institutional implementation of the curriculum

Interpretation: 82% of the students opined the institutional implementation of the curriculum as excellent, 12% believes that implementation of the curriculum is good and 4.9% rated average.



1. Alumni's opinion regarding the adequateness of the courses offered in the program.

Interpretation: 46.5% of the Alumni are satisfied with the choice of course offered and its adequateness, 39.5% rated it to be Excellent while 11.6% believe that it is good and the remaining 2% rated average

2. Alumni's opinion regarding the efficiency of the syllabus content in enabling to face aspects of life

Interpretation: 74% of the alumni are of the opinion that the syllabus content is really efficient, 18% opts it to be good and 7% believes it to be average

3. Alumni's opinion regarding the relevance of the curriculum in relation to your current professional standards

Interpretation: 37% of alumni have really high opinion about the relevance of the curriculum in relation to professional standards, 38.3% rated relevance of the curriculum verygood and 21% are of the opinion that relevance of the curriculum is just satisfactory and 3.4% rated it average

4. Alumni's opinion regarding the skills acquired from the curriculum for practical exposure in life

Interpretation: 63% of alumni are of the opinion that skills acquired from the curriculum is very good and excellent,30% are of the opinion that the skills acquired are good.and remaining 5.8% have an average opinion on the skills acquired

5. Alumni's opinion regarding the choice of electives in providing competence in employability skills& soft skills

Interpretation: 62% of alumni are of the opinion that choice of electives offered will help in promoting competence in skills and remaining 28% are of the opinion that it is good and remaining 9% believe that it is average

6. Alumni's opinion regarding the design of syllabus for self learning

Interpretation: 44.1% of the alumni are of the opinion that syllabus is very good in inculcating & promoting self learning, 28% rated it to be excellent, 22%considers it to be satisfactory and remaining 5.8% are of the opinion that the syllabus rates Average in promoting self learning

7. Alumni's opinion regarding the competence and support offered by the institution for the overall development of the students.

Interpretation: 49% of the alumni are of the opinion that the institution efficiently and excellently supports the students, 29% believes that the offered by the institution is proper, 15.12% rates the support to be good ,3.4% are of the opinion that the support is average and the remaining 3.4% are of the opinion that the support is poor

8. Alumni's rating of the Curriculum enhances various co- curricular activities Sports and Arts meets at University levels

Interpretation: 37% of alumni are of the opinion that curriculum is adequate to perform well in various co-curricular activities, 31.40% considers this aspect to be very good,18.6% opines this to be good and 9.3% rated the aspect to be average while the remaining 3.4% alumni are of the opinion that curricular support is poor in this aspect.
