S.E.S. CHRONICLE Vol 3 Issue 2 Release

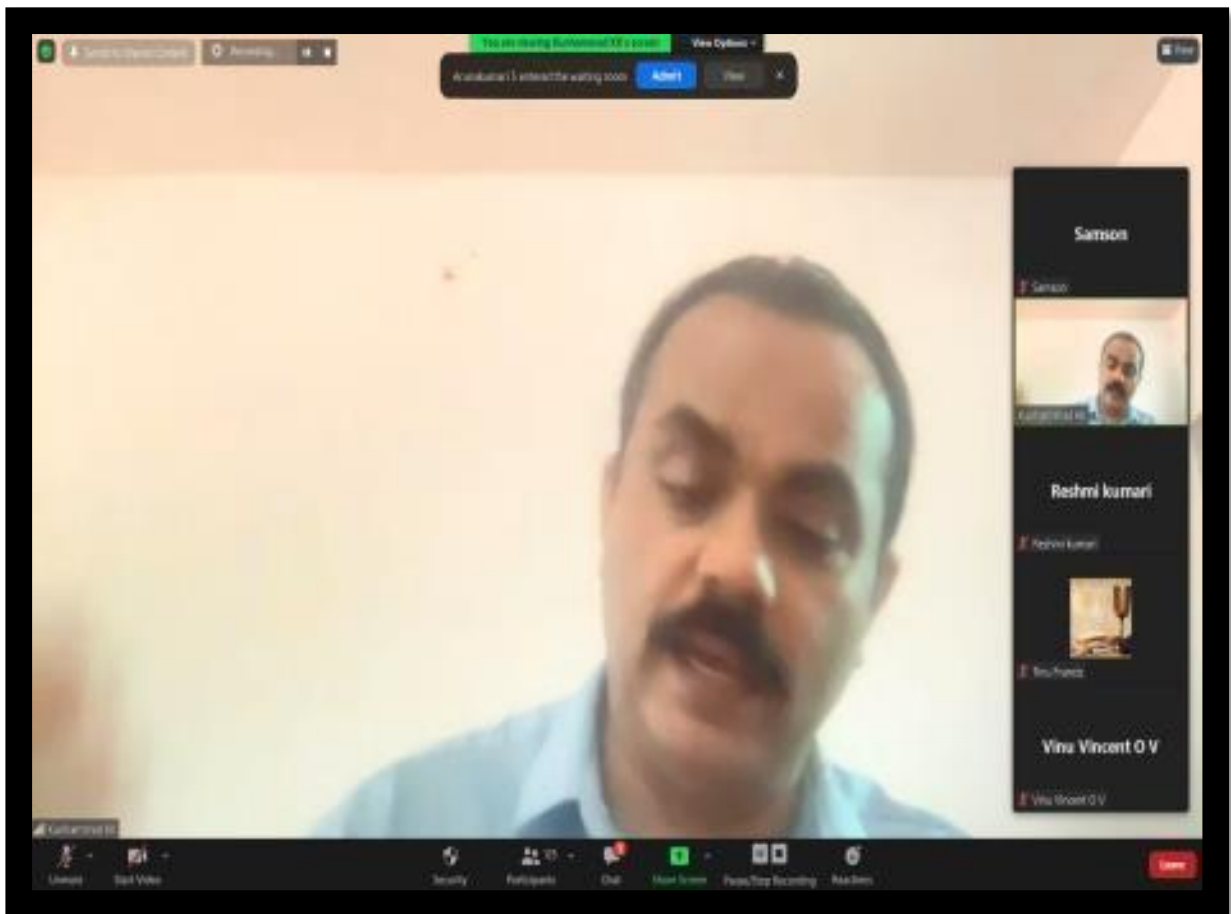

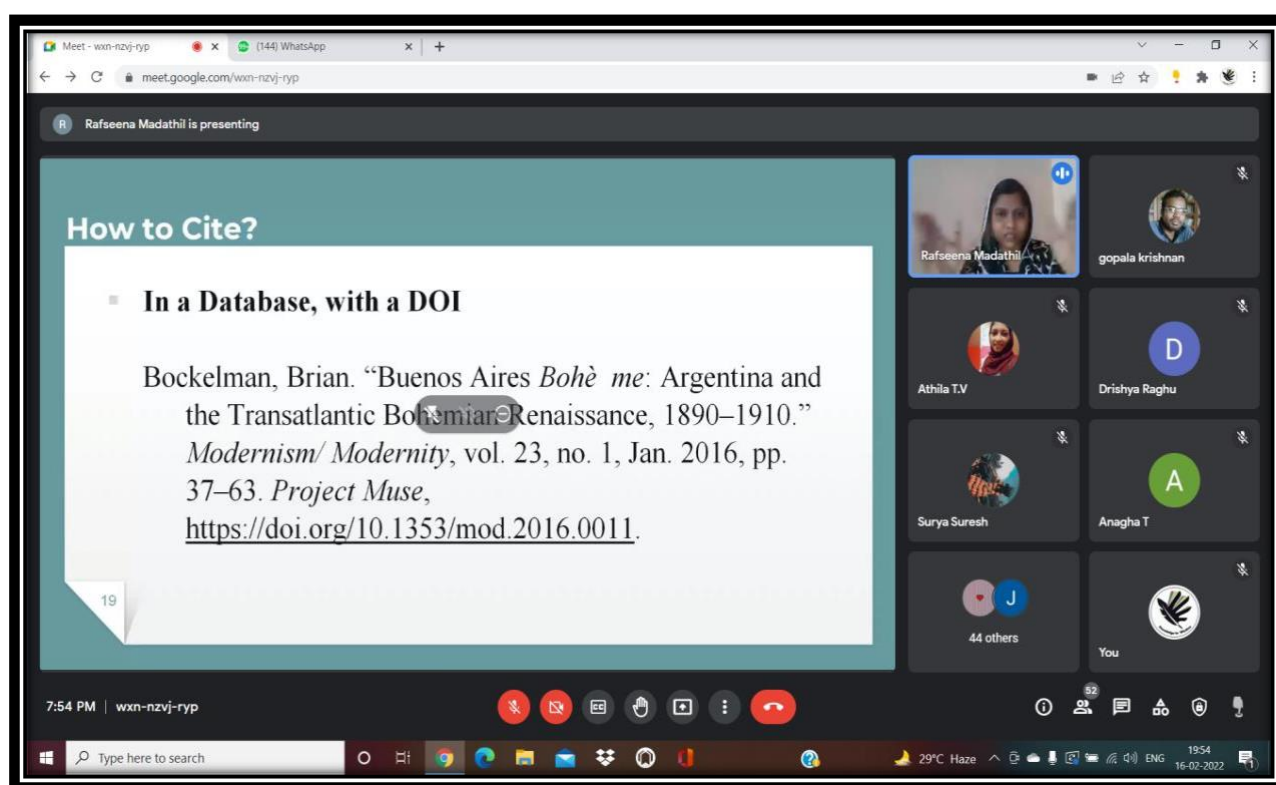
CAREER GUIDANCE SEMINAR
