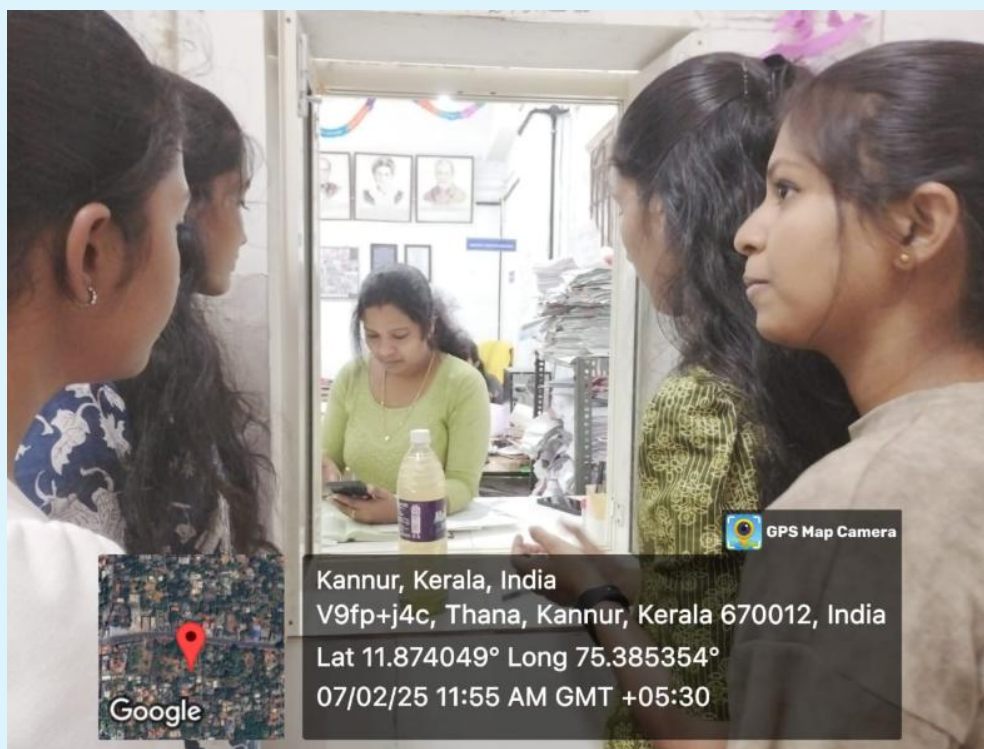
PROGRAMME ON GENDER EQUITY

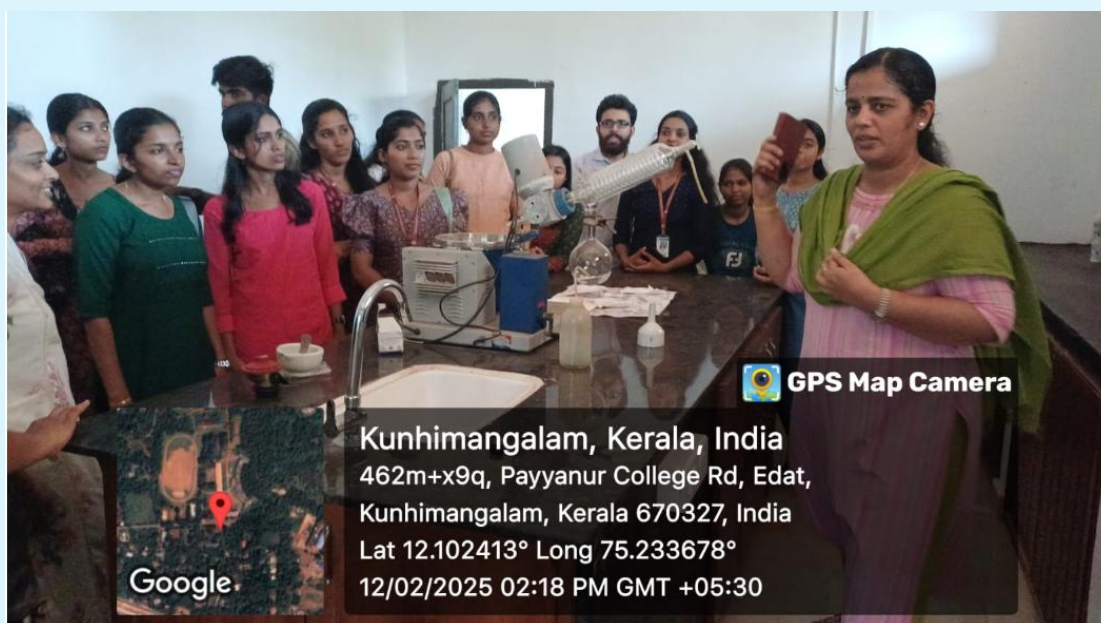
INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO SCHOOL OF CHEMICAL SCIENCES, KANNUR UNIVERSITY

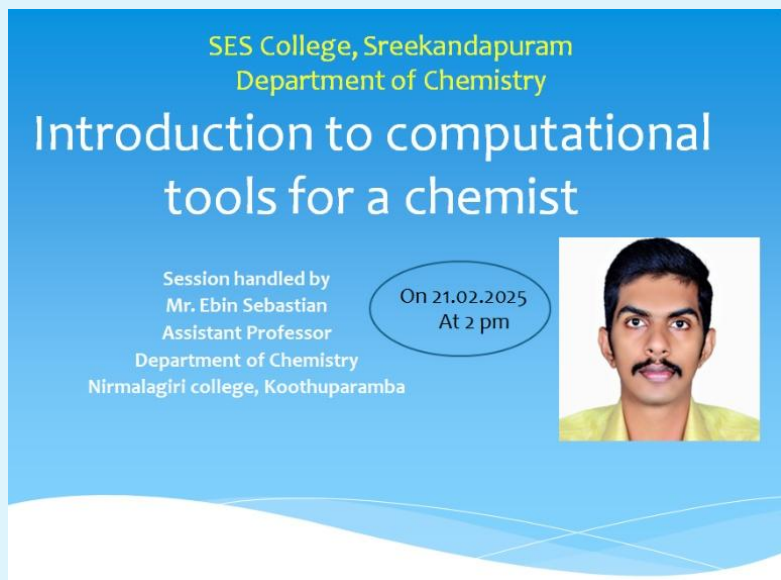
