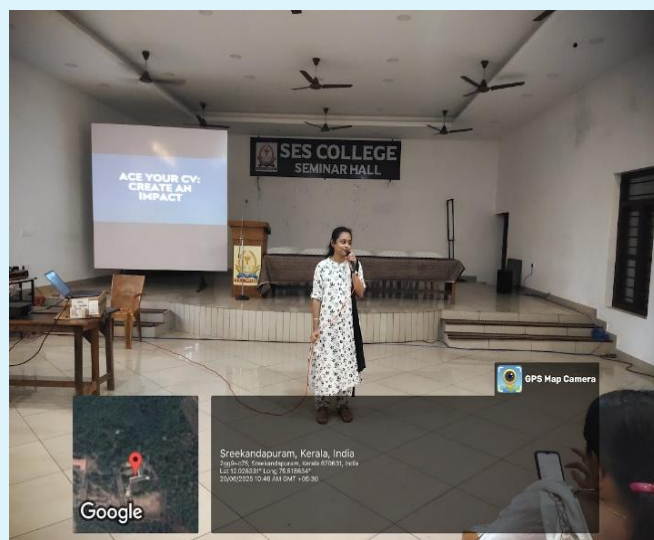


CHEMZONE CLUB INAUGURATION: ACE YOUR CV: CREATE AN IMPACT

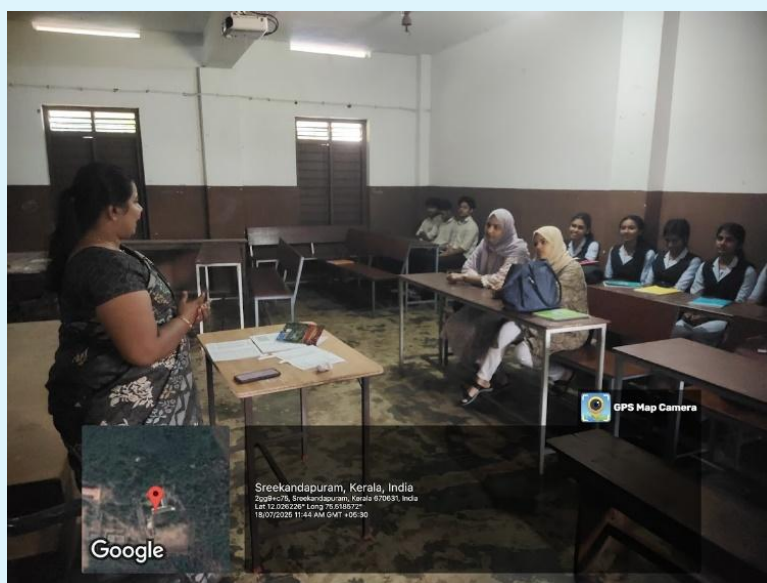


DECISION MAKING SOFT SKILL (ALUMINI ENGAGEMENT PROGRAMME)

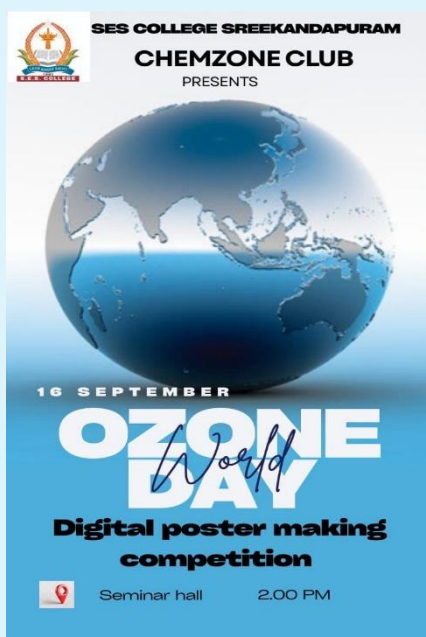
SKILL / ENRICHMENT COURSE

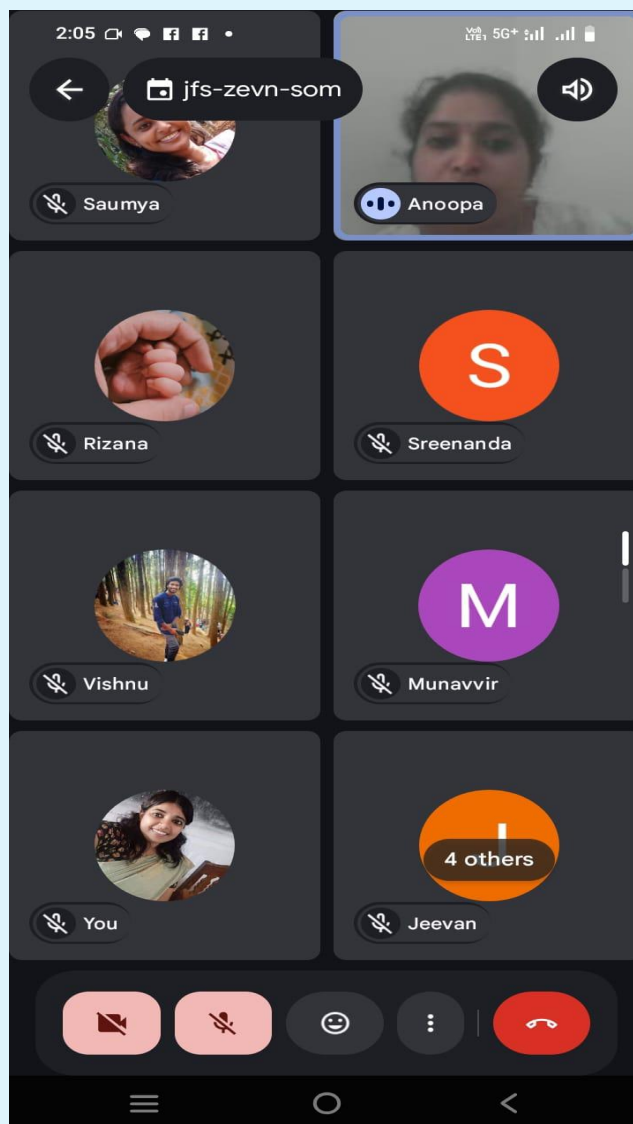
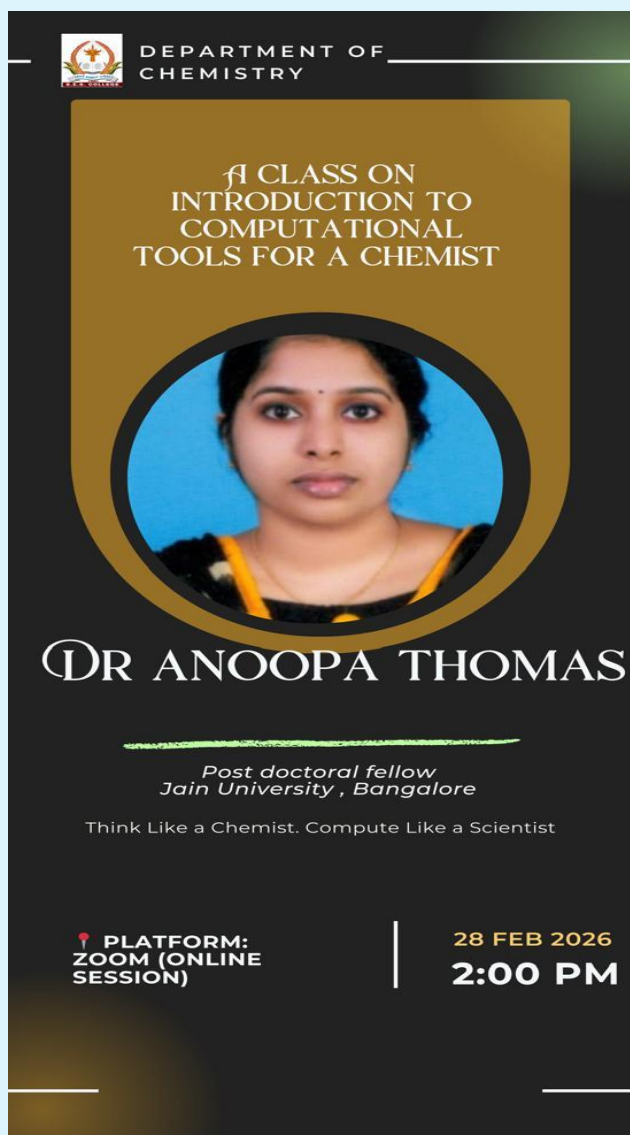
CLASS ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

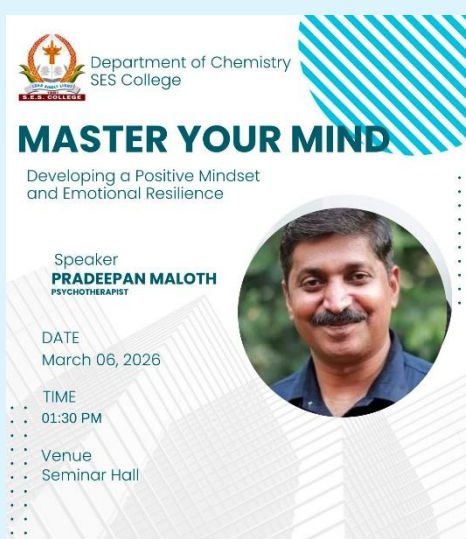
SHIFT THE LENS: INSPIRING EQUITY IN ACTION
