The session was highly interactive, with participants actively engaging in discussions and clarifying doubts. The programme provided a valuable platform for students and faculty to gain exposure to international perspectives in higher mathematics and to explore opportunities for academic collaboration through the MoU. The seminar concluded with an expression of gratitude to the speaker for his enriching contribution and to all participants for making the event a success. **10 students** participated from our department.

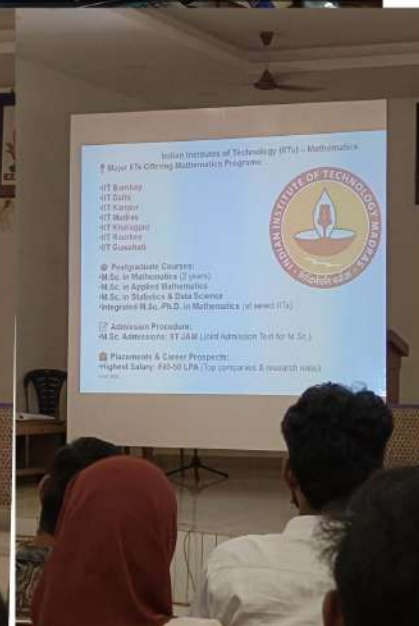
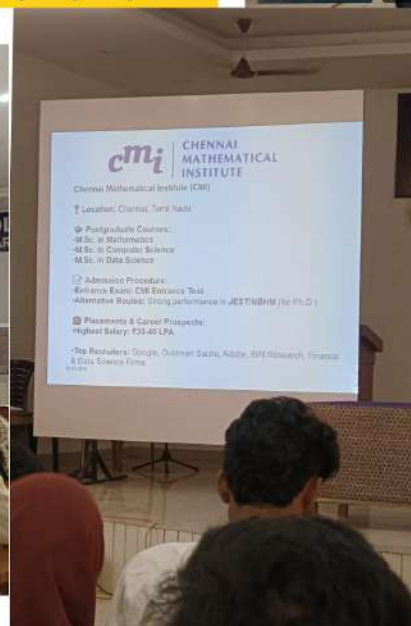

Euler's Day – Sudoku Event

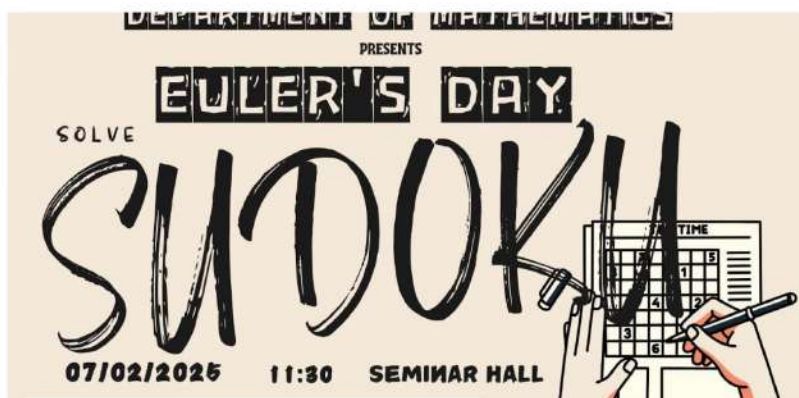

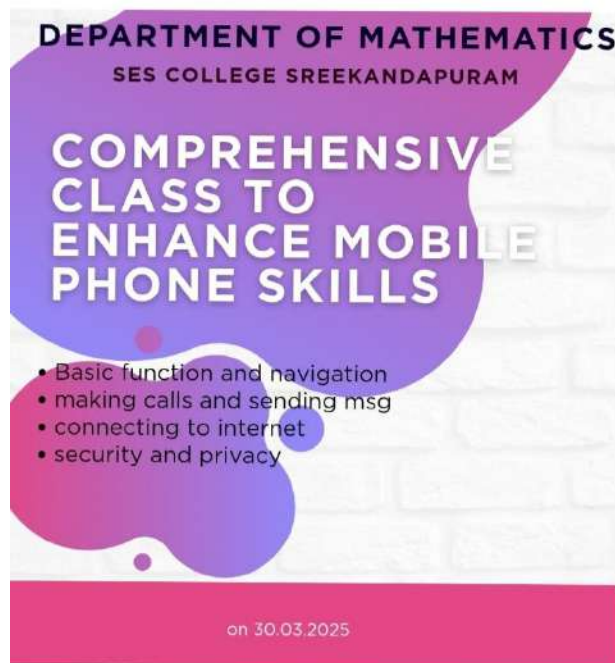
Objective

Bigdata Carnival

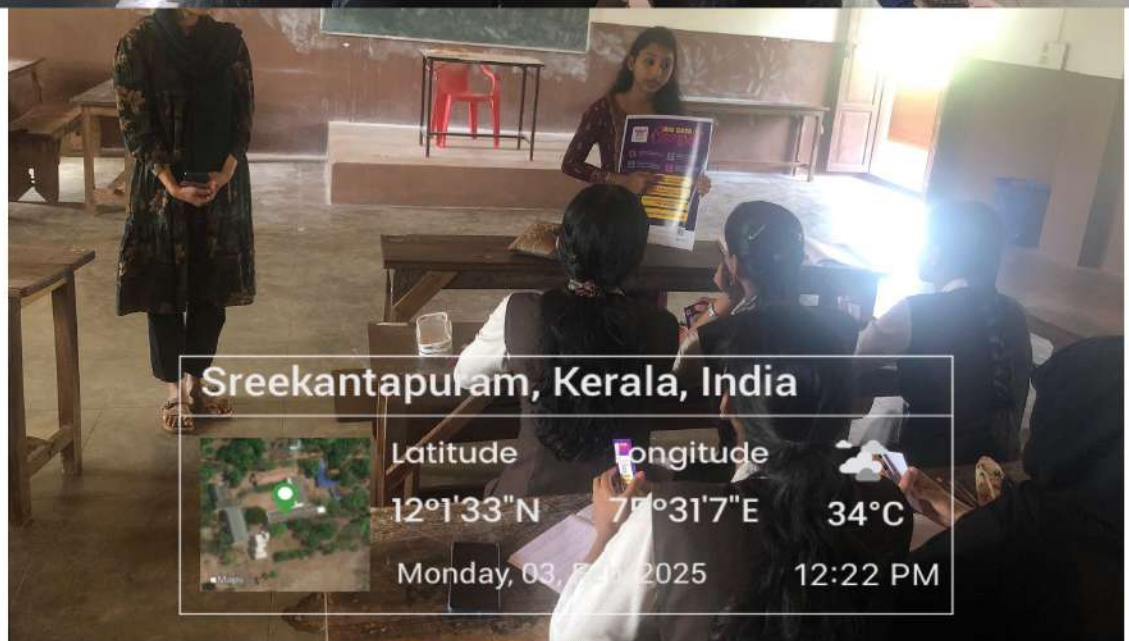
